




<u>WORKSHOP ON CHILD RIGHTS AND PROTECTION – 26.11.2019</u>








THIRKKURAL VIZHA - SEMINAR ON VALUES OF THIRUKKURAL - 28.01.2020




<u>THIRUKKURAL VIZHA -</u> SPECIAL LECTURE ON THIRUKKURAL – 30.01.2021








WEBINAR ON FORGIVENESS – 11.11.2021










GLOBAL HARMONY DAY - 2023







<u>CERTIFICATE COURSE ON THE PHILOSOPHY OF Dr. DAISAKU</u> IKEDA – 11.04.2023
