Agreement for Academic Cooperation between Soka Ikeda College of Arts and Science for Women and Soka University

ARTICLE 1: OBJECTIVE OF THE AGREEMENT

1.1

The purpose of this agreement is to facilitate exchanges of students, scholars and educational materials between the two universities in order to promote academic cooperation and to further the understanding of culture of the two countries concerned. The purpose of faculty exchange is to promote collaborative research projects whereas student exchange is aimed at allowing students to enroll at the host University for Credit which will be recognized by and applied toward their degree at the home institution. This Agreement will be effective from 2010 fall semester.

ARTICLE II: AGREEMENT

2.1

This agreement confirms the cooperation between Soka University and Soka Ikeda College of Arts and Science for Women to increase study abroad opportunities for both Institutions. The Office of the Coordinator of International Exchange Program will have the responsibility for the general administration of the program at Soka Ikeda College of Arts and Science for Women. At Soka University, the Agreement will be administered by the International Affairs Office.

2.2

Both universities agree to accept and enroll exchange as full-time students for the duration of their exchange. The duration will be for I semester (September to January). Both universities shall prepare a detailed program to provide exchange students educational resources, both administrative and academic, to allow the exchange program to yield the maximum effects. This will involve up to two students from both Soka Ikeda College of Arts and Science for Women and Soka University students.

ARTICLE III: RESPONSIBILITY FOR BOTH UNIVESITIES

3.1

Both universities will screen undergraduate students for high academic performance to participate in the exchange program. SOKA UNIVERSITY will send students who will have TOEFL iBT score of 79, or ILETS of 6.0. The number of participating students shall be reciprocal. The period of study for an exchange student will be for one semester. Students who wish to participate in subject sources offered at the host institution need to satisfy the language proficiency requirements of the host institution.

Courses taught in English: Soka University is offering various courses taught in English. In order to find specific courses to be taught in English, the Soka Ikeda College of Arts and Science for Women student (s) should make a contact with the International Affairs Office of Soka University. In addition to those regular courses offered by each Faculty at Soka University, we also offer "Japan Studies Program" (JSP) and Japan Asia Studies (JAS) which offers general education courses in English.

3.4

SOKA UNIVERSITY will facilitate Soka Ikeda College of Arts and Science for Women student's registering into its Japanese Language Course. When the Soka Ikeda College of Arts and Science for Women student reaches a satisfactory commend of the Japanese Language, SOKA UNIVERSITY will facilitate her registration into the courses of the selected specific field and will divulge the respected grade.

3.5

The specific aim of this agreement is to institute and conduct a study abroad program for students of Soka University. Under this agreement, students participating in the program will attend regular courses provided by Soka Ikeda College of Arts and Science for Women.

3.6

Soka Ikeda College of Arts and Science for Women Registrar and Soka University will provide students with an official transcript at the end of each semester.

3.7

The receiving institution will bear the exchange student's expenses with regard to education (admission and tuition fees). The institutions will provide assistance in locating accommodation for the participants.

ARTICLE IV: FACULTY EXCHANGE

4.]

Exchange and visits of academic and other staff (especially for sabbatical leave) and also the encouragement of visits of staff in both directions for the purpose of giving lectures, courses, and mutual discussion of research.

ARTICLE V: RESPONSIBILITY OF PARTICIPATING STUDENTS

If upon termination any issue is still unsettled, the parties shall define, in the form of a Termination Instrument, the mutual liabilities and obligation for the completion or cessation of any work in progress and any other outstanding liabilities, and shall ensure that work in progress is completed, notwithstanding termination.

ARTICLEM: CONTROVERSY SOLUTION

8.1

For the purpose of settling any doubts or disputes that may arise concerning the performance or construction of this Agreement, the parties shall exert their best efforts to arrive at a solution by consent. Should consent prove to be feasible, the parties shall appoint, by mutual consent, a third party (a natural person) to act as mediator.





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Agreement for Academic Cooperation between Soka Ikeda College of Arts and Science for Women and Soka University

ARTICLE I: OBJECTIVE OF THE AGREEMENT

The purpose of this agreement is to facilitate exchanges of students, scholars and educational materials between the two universities in order to promote academic cooperation and to further the understanding of culture of the two countries concerned. The purpose of faculty exchange is to promote collaborative research projects whereas student exchange is aimed at allowing students to enroll at the host University for Credit which will be recognized by and applied toward their degree at the home institution. This agreement will be effective from the date when both parties signed on this agreement.

ARTICLE II: AGREEMENT

This agreement confirms the cooperation between Soka University and Soka Ikeda College of Arts and Science for Women to increase study abroad opportunities for both institutions. The office of the coordinator of international exchange program will have the responsibility for the general administration of the program at Soka Ikeda College of Arts and Science for Women. semester. Students who wish to participate in subject courses offered at the host institution need to satisfy the language proficiency requirements of the host institution.

The student(s) from Soka Ikeda College of Arts and Science for Women can take any open-classes offered under various faculty, except for Faculty of Nursing, depending on their language proficiency.

Courses taught in English: Soka University is offering various courses taught in English. In order to find specific courses to be taught in English, student(s) from Soka Ikeda College of Arts and Science for Women should make a contact with international affairs office of Soka University.

Soka University will facilitate registration of the students from Soka Ikeda College of Arts and Science for Women into its Japanese language course. When the students from Soka Ikeda College of Arts and Science for Women reach a satisfactory commend of the Japanese language, Soka University will facilitate their registration into the courses of the selected specific field and will divulge the respected grade.

3.5

The Specific aim of this agreement is to institute and conduct a study abroad program for students of Soka University. Under this agreement, students participating in the program will attend regular courses provided by Soka Ikeda College of Arts and Science for Women.

3.6

Soka Ikeda College of Arts and Science for Women Registrar and Soka University will provide students with an official transcript at the end of each semester.

3.7

The receiving institution will bear the exchange student's expenses with regard to education (admission and tuition fees). The institutions will provide assistance in locating accommodation for the participants.

ARTICLE IV: FACULTY EXCHANGE

4.1

Exchange and visits of academic and other staff (especially for sabbatical leave) and also the encouragement of visits of staff in both directions for the purpose of giving lectures, courses, and mutual discussion of research.

ARTICLE V: RESPONSIBILITY OF PARTICIPATING STUDENTS

The exchange students shall procure health insurance coverage in her home country before arrival at the host institution.

ARTICLE VIII: CONTROVERSY SOLUTION

For the purpose of settling any doubts or disputes that may arise concerning the performance or construction of this agreement, the parties shall exert their best efforts to arrive at a solution by consent. Should consent prove to be feasible, the parties shall appoint, by mutual consent, a third party to act as mediator.

Women facing Psychological, Sexual, Emotional, Physical and Financial abuse, regardless of age, class, caste, education status, marital status, race and culture is assisted with support. NSCC provides specialized services such as Therapeutic Counselling, Guidance on Employment and Empowerment and Legal Advises.

E. Soka Ikeda College, the second part – Soka Ikeda College of Arts and Science for Women, Chennai – 600 099 is an ISO 9001: 2005 certified institution and is affiliated to the University of Madras. The College aims to deliver university education to benefit and uplift the students and society through systematic knowledge assimilation and delivery at all levels.

Now therefore, the parties hereto agree to sign a general framework agreement on collaboration, subject to specific annexes, which will permit the exchange of experience and the organisation of joint activities, in close collaboration:

CLAUSE 1: CO-OPERATION

- Establishing a Counselling unit, and a counsellor from NSCC visits the College once in a fortnight/month.

Additional areas may be identified in the future.

Now, therefore the parties hereto agree to sign a general framework agreement on collaboration, subject to specific annexes, which will permit the exchange of experience and the organisation of joint activities, in close collaboration, in accordance to the following objectives:

- To establish close collaboration in all relevant fields
- To enable the exchange of information between both institutions in all areas relating to training and teaching activities.
- To promote joint study in areas relevant to Psychology, Social Work and other relevant areas that may be identified in the future.
- To study ways of working together that will lead to greater participation for both bodies in other relevant institutions.




