CAREER GUIDANCE ON 26.03.2025

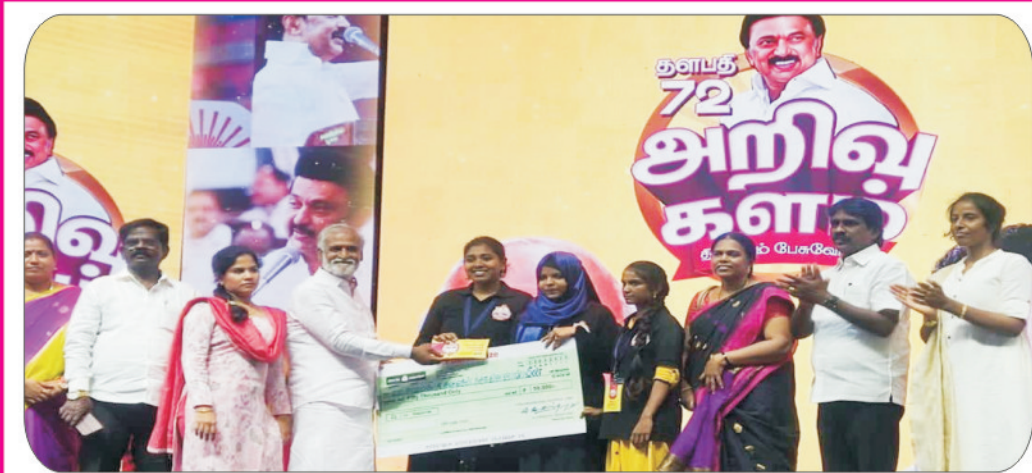
