PROFILE OF THE COLLEGE

Soka Ikeda College of Arts and Science for Women is founded by our Chairman, Dr. Sethu Kumanan. Under his visionary and leadership, and with his determination to serve humanity, this pioneering institution for women was established in the village of Madhanangkuppam, with the main focus on empowering women through value based education.

This education system is modeled after the Soka Education System. The word 'Soka' is from the Japanese language, which means "to create value", was formulated by Tsunesaburo Makiguchi in 1930, along with his other profound teaching pedagogies. Soka Education system is based on virtue and peace and seeks to nurture the latent talent of the students while laying a strong foundation on values. This value based education was followed by Josei Toda and then by Dr. Daisaku Ikeda, who is the Honorary Founder of the college.

Dr. Daisaku Ikeda, is a world renowned Educator, prodigious writer, Buddhist Philosopher, Photographer, Poet of Eminence and is an epitome of Peace. He is the founder of Soka University (Tokyo), Soka Women's College (Tokyo), Soka University of America (USA) and the Soka Schools.

In recognition of Dr. Ikeda's accomplishments, various institutions have honoured him with awards such as the "United Nation Peace Award, the Poet Laureate Award by the World Poet Association. He has been regarded as "one of the greatest leaders of the 20th Century" by the University of Delhi and awarded him, "The Doctorates of Letters" in January 1999. Bharathidasan University conferred the Honorary Doctorate of Letters to Dr. Ikeda in 2002. Besides, he is also the proud recipient of Jamnalal Bajaj International Award in 2005 for promoting Gandhian values across the world. Dr. Ikeda has been awarded 403 honorary doctorates, many professorships and equivalent honours from various Universities across the world in recognition of his efforts to promote peace. With the motivation and support rendered by our Honorary Founder, college has been steadily growing in the path of creating empowered women for more than two decades.

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR STUDENTS

Classes for Shift I begins at 9 am and continue till 2.15 pm with a lunch break of half- an- hour from 11.55 am to 12.25 pm and for Shift II the classes begins at 11.00 am and ends at 4.15 pm with a break of 10 minutes 2.15 pm to 2.25 pm.

Day order system is followed and each every working day is divided into 5 academic periods followed by a period allotted for Para-academic activities.

Attendance is taken every hour and if a student is absent for one hour in the forenoon or afternoon sessions, she will be marked absent for that entire session.

A student must have a minimum of 75% attendance to appear for the University Examinations.

Students who wish to avail leave must submit leave application in advance duly signed by the parent/guardian to the respective class teacher. However, in case of emergency, the leave form can be submitted on the day when the student returns to the college.

Students should apply for leave only in the given prescribed form (each student will be given 5 copies of leave form per semester). Further copies of leave forms can be obtained from the office at a cost of Rs.5/- each.

When a student avails leave for illness, she should produce Medical certificate issued by a Registered Medical Practitioner along with leave form.

Students must avoid availing leave during Internal Assessment Examination.

It is obligatory on the part of each and every student to adhere to the rules and regulations of the college for maintaining good standard, discipline and decorum. They should conduct themselves properly both within and outside the college premises.

The students should not be absent for the special/coaching classes conducted for their benefit.

Strict silence should be observed during the class hours and when classes are dismissed, students should move from one class to another in an orderly manner without disturbing the other classes.

Students should update themselves with the notification put up on the notice board from time to time.

Students are expected to take proper care of the college property and help in keeping the college premises neat and clean.

Every student should try to emulate the principles of great personalities and aim to achieve success and perfection in all their endeavours. The conduct, character, behaviour and the progress in studies of each student should be satisfactory.

In case of any emergency, the student shall be permitted to leave the college campus only with the accompaniment of the parent and a gate pass duly signed by the Principal.

No communication will be entertained from anyone other than the parents' either through telephone or letter. Change of residence and mobile number of parent/guardian, if any, should be intimated to the class-in-charge/HOD.

The students should pay their semester fees within the last date for payment of the semester fees as mentioned in the college calendar. For delayed payment, a penalty of Rs.200/- will be collected.

Students are responsible of their belongings and should avoid bringing valuable articles to the college. The Management, Principal and Staff are not responsible for the loss of any belongings of the student inside the college campus.

If a student, after completion of one or two years of study, wants to get transfer certificate in the beginning of the next year even without attending the class, she has to pay full fees to the college for the remaining period of the course. A student who discontinues in the middle of the semester should pay the fees for the entire course to get the transfer certificate.

Breach of any of the above rules will lead to disciplinary action. The management seeks kind co operation of the parents/guardian in this regard to help the college to do its best for the students.

EXAMINATION

Each department conducts periodical tests for the students apart from two internal assessments and a model examination which is conducted in common for all the students each semester on university examination pattern. Attendance for all the students in all the examinations is compulsory. After the model examination, internal marks (25) are assessed based on the performance of the student in test, attendance of the student seminar taken and assignment submitted by the student. External assessment is for 75 marks except for Soft Skills. The monthly attendance secured by the students will be informed to the parent/guardian along with their performance in the Internal Assessment Test. The parent/guardian must carefully read the report and advice their wards suitably. In case of loss of report card student should avail a new report card on payment of Rs.100/-.

IDENTITY CARD

Each student will be given a college identity card at the beginning of the first year. The student must strictly wear the identity card inside the college premises failing which they will not be permitted to attend the class. In the event of loss of ID card, students can get a new ID card from the college office on payment of Rs. 200/-.

At the end of each semester, students should return the book and get the no due from the librarian. Photocopying and internet facility is available in the library. Strict silence should be maintained in the library. A fine of Rs.2/- per day (including holidays) will be levied for late return of book.
